3. Main new functionalities and minor changes

3.1 Stock Monitoring Tool

- SMT (Stock Monitoring Tool) offers a digital & secure solution to pharmaceutical players to declare their stocks of medicines marked as essential by the Federal Agency for Medicines and Health Products (FAMHP). This will allow the FAMHP to have a view onto the availability of essential medicines and to take action in the event of a risk of shortage.

The digital solution is composed of a web application and a webservice, having the same pharmaceutical target groups involved in SMT (= the registrants):

- public pharmacies (PP - public pharmacies)
- hospital pharmacies (HP - hospital pharmacies)
- Marketing Authorization Holders (MAH)
- wholesaler-distributor (GR – Grossistes Répartiteurs)
- Parallel Importers (PI)
- Parallel Distributors (PD)
