3. Main new functionalities and minor changes

3.1 Addressbook WS

The eHealth Addressbook WS (SOAP & REST versions) offers new search options in this new version. A number of combinations of search criteria that were not possible until now are being added to increase the usability of the WS.

3.2 ConsultRN Family Composition Service

Consultation of the household compositions of individuals recorded in the databases of the National Register and the BCSS; the individual for whom the household composition is requested is not required to be the head of the household.

3.3 ConsultRN Waiting Register Service

The SOAP web service RN Consult Waiting Register Service allows the consultation of certain data from the national register concerning the waiting register, more specifically regarding refugees during their recognition procedure.

3.4 Mult-eMediAtt: Iteration 2 –Directory Adaptation

Within the framework of the Mult-eMediAtt project, the Directory is being adapted to add greater granularity to the dataset used in the certificate, based on the type of recipient.

3.5 Mult-eMediAtt – ADA –DAAS CIN Consultation

The mutual insurance sector is added as a potential recipient to receive a Mult-eMediAtt even in cases where the work incapacity is less than 100%. Target Group concerned: General practitioners

3.6 Mult-eMediAtt - Adjustment of DAAS Business Rules for HR RAIL

Adjustment of the DAAS business rules in the Mult-eMediAtt project to reflect legal requirements related to HR RAIL.
